Good morning I want to give a huge thank you for a great year last year. We are all on a great path for another successful year.

I just have a few things to go over first. EL's, each one of you should have appointed a hoop shoot charima. By now and most of you should have your lodge shoots scheduled. I currently only have dates for 2 lodges. Which brings me to the 2nd thing, each hoop shoot charima needs a grand lodge login immediately. If your charima are unable to figure this out please get with them immediately and help them get one. As we are scheduling out lodge shoots the charima should log into grand lodge website and post their lodge contest date. Many times returning competitors or parents and

grandparents and even school PE teachers, principals, or volunteers are checking this for an upcoming date. Before they even receive your packet. Last year I received 14 calls from these exact people looking for dates. We only had 2 O lodges pre post their hoopshoot on the grandlodge site. Let's please improve those numbers this year. 3rd thing is your packet, you mail or deliver to your schools. Each one should include a score sheet the 3 page instruction fold out a poster and a personal letter from you with your contact info and date of lodge shoot. If you want to personalize letters to schools that have participated in the past with statistics of previous kids it makes a good impression. Please make sure you repeatedly announce your hoopshoot at lodge meetings and functions to ensure you have plenty of volunteers. A properly

run shoot should have a minimum of 13 to 14 volunteer helpers.

3 score keepers for each end of the court 1 line judges per end 2 shaggers and 1-2 people in to run the registration desk.

I know many of us are busy and forget that we sign up to volunteer for things that's why it's a great idea to call your volunteers a few days before your shoot to make sure they remember and are still available. Try to have back up.

The District dates for this year are North District Chairman Brian Lindsay January 4th at Wasatch Recreation Center in Heber Utah registration will be at 11:30, South District Chairman Jari Smith January 11th @ Cedarview Middle School in Cedar City registration will be @ 10:30.
