MEMBERSHIP REPORT FOR MAY 2021

I want to start out by reminding all lodges that the end of the membership year is May 31st. We are currently about half way through the 60 day reinstatement period.

Have your lodge secretaries review Section 14.180 of the Statues. The secretaries must contact all members dropped on March 31, 2021 for nonpayment. A letter must be sent out to each member who was dropped at year-end. On April 1, 2021, I forwarded on to each lodge a letter from Rick Gathen (Grand Lodge Membership & Marketing Manager), explaining about the reinstatement period and how to generate the reinstatement letter. If your lodge hasn't sent out the letter or you are not sure of the process to generate the letter, let me know and I can send the information directly on to you.

Now is the critical time to bring members back in. Offer those dropped, reinstatement without penalty fees or interruption of service. They just need to pay membership dues. If the member is having financial issues, offer the option to pay half a years dues.

Next, I want talk about restoring our Membership. Many of our members have dropped because of the pandemic. They did not or still don't fill comfortable in large gatherings. Address their concerns, let the members know of the precautions that your lodges are taking. Social distancing, wearing of masks, and sanitizing your lodge. Let the members know about coming events and how you are addressing their health issues for that event. Bring the members back to ELKDOM.

Business Practice Report

The Secretary's manual states that Lodge Secretary's receipts should be reconciled with the Treasurer's receipts each month. Delay increases difficulty in identifying discrepancies. Personally, I believe the receipts should be reconciled immediately, or as soon after the deposit as possible.

Statutes set forth the requirement for three reviews during the year by the Auditing and Accounting Committee. If the Committee is conscientious and carries out its duties diligently, the Lodge will have much greater assurance that accounting data is reliable.

The Secretary's Manual suggests that lodges should use recording cash registers with sufficient flexibility to record all sales by product and other miscellaneous cash receipts. A numbered continuous tape should be locked with each cash register while it is in use.

Food service sales checks should be pre-numbered in sequential order and accounted for daily. Missing sales checks should be investigated by the supervisor.

There should be an established policy for action to be taken on cash shortages and overages.

Remember to break down your boxes before taking them to the dumpster. This helps reduce the possibility of food or alcohol being carried out in the box to be picked up later.

Following these procedures should help reduce losses to the Lodge, making it more profitable.


Report to State Convention 2021 for the UEA Directory

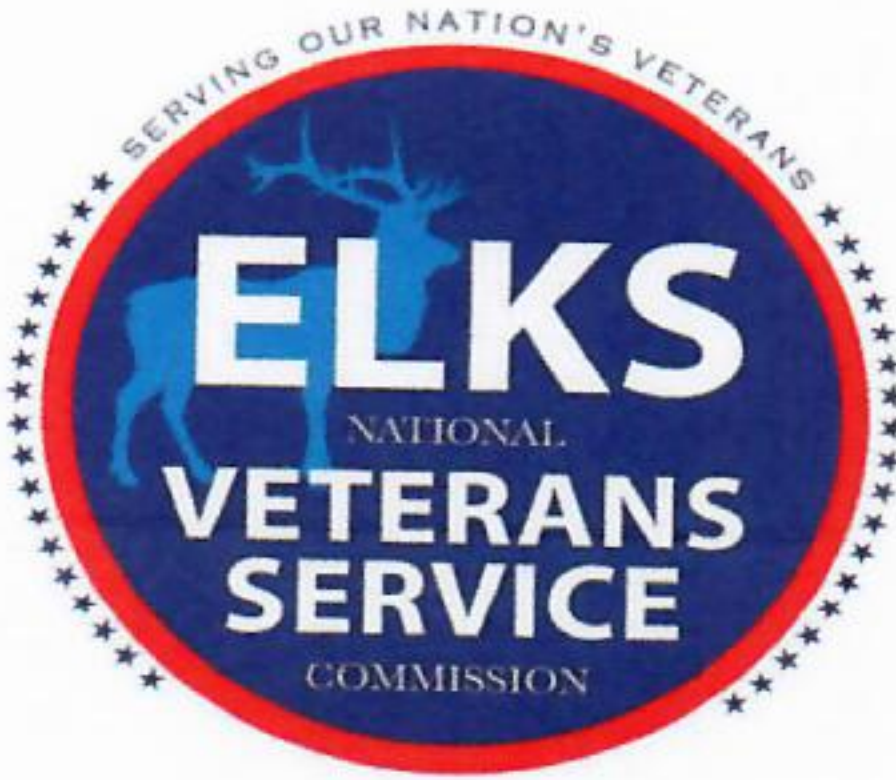

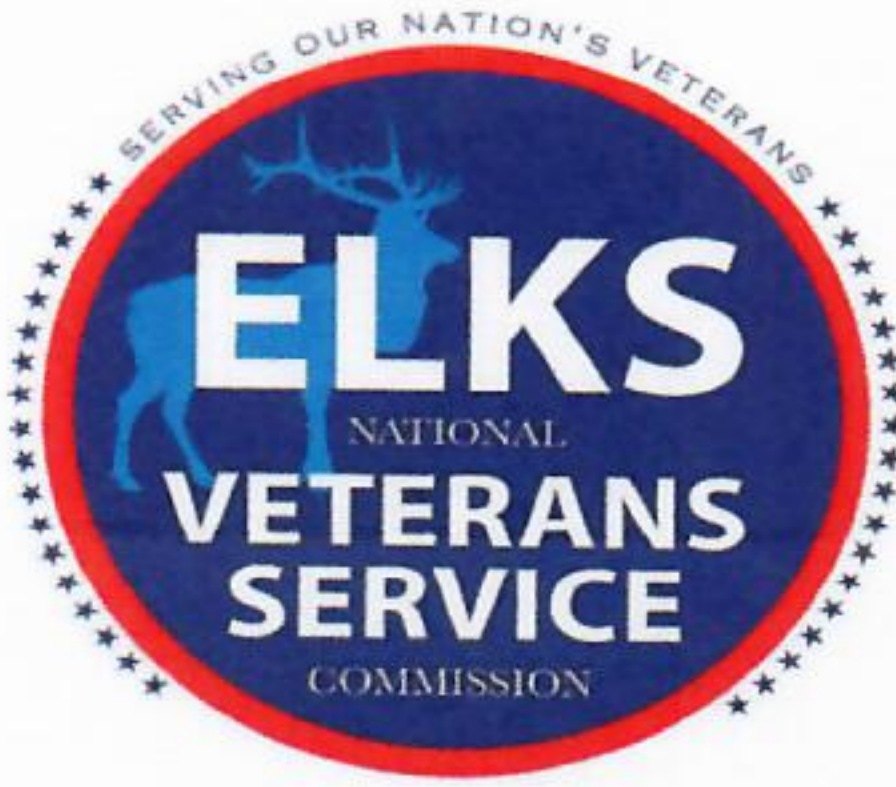
