Throughout the State of Utah our ELK Veteran Committees have spent time, energy, and money to assist the worthy Veterans who live here. We have given particular care to our Veterans who reside in the VA facilities. Funds have gone to the Homes in Ogden, Payson, Salt Lake, and the Southern Utah Home in Ivins. We have provided funds and assistance with Birthday cakes, planting flower boxes, fishing trips, bird seed and bird feeders, clothing where needed as well as lots of candy for many holidays and functions.

Networking with other Veteran groups and organizations in our communities has benefited veterans in need. I would encourage our Exalted Rulers to ask their Veteran Committees to reach out and connect with like-minded groups. In St George our network includes the St George Veterans Coalition, Utah Tech University Veterans Club, the Rotary Veterans Club, the Vietnam Veterans Club, the American Legion, the local DAR chapter, our city government and the Department of Veterans and Military Affairs Southern Outreach Manager. Participating in joint meetings and building relationships has allowed us to help veterans in our community at a level that we could not do alone. We have helped young Veterans that have had financial problems help pay their high utility bills, provided grocery and gas cards when needed and through these contacts provided rent assistance. We have also helped in job placement.

St George has also started the National Adopt a Vet Program at three local retirement homes. We hope to expand the program as more volunteers join us.

But by using the same enthusiasm that helped increase our membership we should be able to lower this number. Just a suggestion, if their reason is financial. See if your lodge can assist them with this by offering to pay for at least six months or even the whole year of the membership cost. As our state presidents theme for the year says. Elks Leading by Example, Is a great way to show we care.

One suggestion I would like to give to all our lodges to help increase membership in the coming year and years after is to get rid of some of our community's thoughts that we are just a bar in Utah where you can drink without purchasing food. You can do this by getting involved in your community. Get yourselves out there. Go to their city meetings wearing your Elks shirt, Participate in parades, make some buddy benches and put them around your towns, Have some car shows, Have golf tournaments, and more. There is so much you can do as lodges. But the bottom line is you all have shown the ability to increase membership in our state and you should be proud of this! I know I am.

Congratulations to all the newly elected and appointed officers for the year 2023-2024. This is a busy time of transition. I want to stress the importance of reviewing your Property Plus Certificates of Coverage and invoice that will be arriving in April. The Property Plus Insurance Guide is on Line and is posted on the Safety & insurance page of the Elks website.

This is also the time for the Trustees to appoint one of the their members to be the Accident Prevention Person and to do the monthly self inspection. This needs to be done by that person not by the manager. There is a Self-Inspection Form that needs to be filled out monthly, not just before the District Deputy comes. This is Section 12.070 of the Laws of the Order.

Please remember that when you rent the lodge facilities that whom ever rents must provide an additional certificate that names the Lodge as additional insured. If the Additional Insured Certificate is not provided, Facility Rental policies can be obtained by contacting Gallagher Insurance at (800-421-3557). Facility Rental policies are also available on the Elks website on the Safety & insurance page.

Please, Please, remember that the service of Alcohol is a privilege of the Lodge and must always be watchful of over serving, and observing all of the Utah State Liquor Laws. Please ca me if you have questions or concerns. If I am unable to answer them I will do my best to find the answer form a qualified source.
